HERE ARE THE 4 ESSENTIAL STEPS.




STEP 1 SIGN UP & VERIFICATION

Sign up to WayHome and start your journey of becoming a participant, host, or housemate! To ensure everyone's safety, we have put in place two verification processes. When signing up, a form of ID recognised by the Australian law and contact details of a professional reference are required.

STEP 2 MATCHING

After you have been verified, as a host or housemate, you can search and connect with NDIS participants whom you think you could provide the appropriate support to. Consider the accessibility of your house, the number of hours, or the kind of support you can provide to someone. Similarly, as an NDIS participant, you can search and connect with hosts or housemates that match your individualised living requirements.





STEP 3 SERVICE PROPOSAL

Once a connection is made and both parties want to start a living arrangement, we will start the Individualized Living Option process through NDIS registered provider My Supports. In the service proposal we gather all the information regarding what services and supports are going to be included in the quote, including additional daily living support.

STEP 4 START A LIVING ARRANGEMENT

Time to greet your newest companion! Your Neighbourhood Team Leader will be in touch monthly to make sure both parties are happy and comfortable in their new arrangement.
